Facts: After several medical providers were deposed, the claimant was found to have an

ongoing temporary partial disability, despite the fact that at least one of her doctors had found an ongoing total disability. The claimant appealed to the Board Panel, which

affirmed the Law Judge's decision. This appeal ensued.

Holding: *Affirmed*.

Discussion: The Board provided a detailed explanation for why it credited certain evidence over

others and did not simply ignore the claimant's doctor's opinion or provide only a cursory review, as asserted by the claimant's attorney. This being the case, and inasmuch

as there was substantial evidence to support the Board's determination, it was affirm.
