Facts: Decedent had a myocardial infarction while removing a gas tank at work. Carrier

controverted on the basis that the MI was due to pre-existing factors and was not work-related. The claim was established as a compensable death claim, carrier

appealed, and the Board Panel Affirmed.

Holding: Affirmed.

Discussion: A heart injury precipitated by work-related physical strain is compensable, even if

a pre-existing pathology may have been a contributing factor and the physical exertion was no more severe than that regularly encountered by the claimant. The Board's finding that decedent's death is causally-related to his work activity

is supported by substantial evidence and will not be disturbed.
